

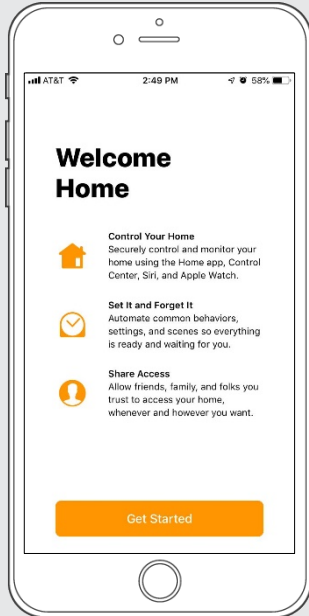

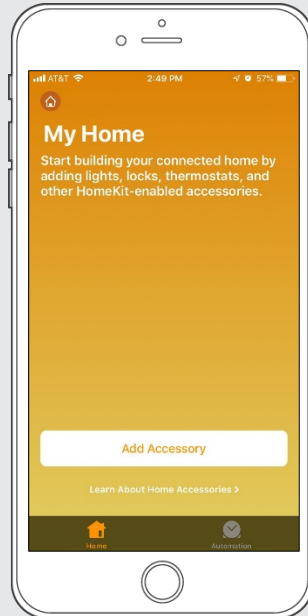
## QUICK START GUIDE APPLE HOME KIT

### STEP 1



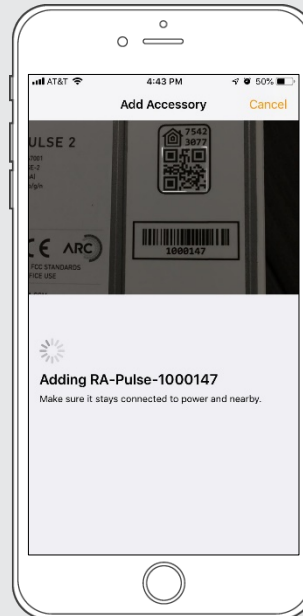
Open the "HomeKit" mobile App.

### STEP 2



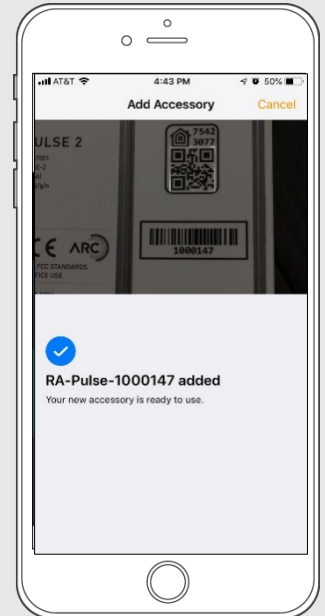
From the Home Screen, select "Add Accessory" at the bottom of the page.

### STEP 3



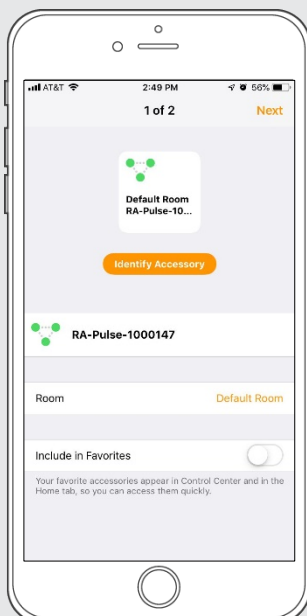
Scan the QR Code at the rear of the Hub, to synchronize with the HomeKit function of your Apple device.

### STEP 4



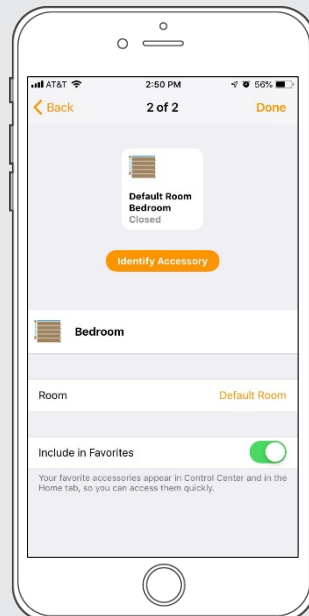
The Hub was added on the HomeKit App.

### STEP 5



Press the "Next" Button to move forward with the Hub.

### STEP 6



The Hub is ready to be used. Press "Done" to start using the HomeKit app to control shade.





# How to Operate the Shades

**STEP 7**




On the Home screen, press and hold the "Shade Icon" to start controlling your shade.

**STEP 8**




Close the shade by scrolling the (white) line to the bottom.

**STEP 9**



Move the shade to any position desired, by scrolling the (white) line to any position.


**STEP 10**



Open the shade, by scrolling the (white) line to the top position.


# How to Create a Scene

**STEP 11**




Press anywhere on the screen to go back to the Home Screen.

**STEP 12**




Click in the "+" and select the, "Add Scene" button to begin programming your desired scene.

**STEP 13**



Select the suggested scene in the App, or create a custom Scene as desired.

**STEP 14**



If you select the "Good Morning" Scene, you can Open a shade or group of shades, as have been programmed.

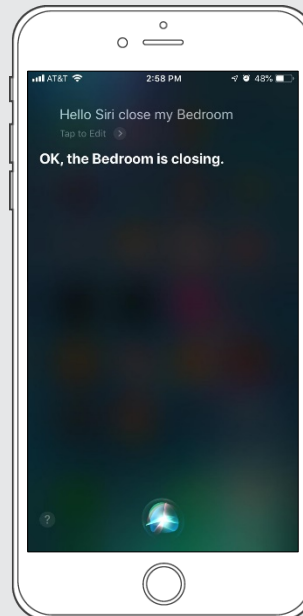
## How to Control your Shades using "Siri"

The Home kit App allows you use the "Siri" Voice control through your iPhone, iPad or IWatch.

You just need to Say, "Hello Siri" and followed by ...

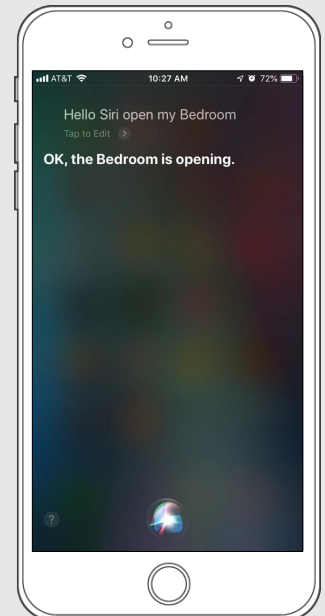
- Close <blinds name>
- Close <room name> blinds
- Close <blinds nick name>
- Set <blinds names> to <percentage>
- Close <blinds name> <adverb>
- Close <blinds name> <direction>
- Close blinds halfway
- Open blinds halfway
- Open <blinds name>
- Open <Room Name> Blinds
- Open <blinds nick name>
- Open <blinds names> to <percentage>
- Open <blinds name> <adverb>
- Open <blinds name> <direction>
- Set <blinds name> <percentage>
- Are <blinds name> open?
- Rotate <blinds name> to <degrees>
- Rotate <blinds name> to <percentage>
- Rotate <blinds name> <degrees> clockwise
- Rotate <blinds name> <degrees> counterclockwise
